With the increasing number of foreign nationals residing in Korea, the demand for legal services related to visas, residence, and nationality continues to grow. Additionally, due to a lack of understanding of immigration and citizenship systems, there has been a rise in cases where individuals face unexpected legal and administrative issues.

In particular, when a foreign national violates domestic laws, they are subject to immigration offense review in addition to criminal penalties, and depending on the circumstances, may face serious disadvantages such as deportation or restrictions on their stay status. Therefore, an immediate response is of utmost importance.
